

CORPORATION OF THE NATION MUNICIPALITY

By-law 22-2025

Being a by-law to appoint a Deputy Chief Building Official for The Nation Municipality

WHEREAS Section 3(2) of the *Ontario Building Code Act, 1992, SO 1992, c 23*, requires that each Municipality appoints a Chief Building Official and such inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of said Act.

WHEREAS Section 77(b) of the *Legislation Act, 2006, S.O. 2006, c. 21, Sched. F* states that the Power to appoint a person to a public office includes power to appoint a deputy with the same powers as the holder of the office, subject to specific conditions, or with limited powers as specified.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of The Nation Municipality deems it expedient to appoint a Deputy Chief Building Official to enforce the provisions of the provisions of the *Ontario Building Code Act, 1992, SO 1992, c 23*.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE NATION MUNICIPALITY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Alexandre St-Amour be hereby appointed as Deputy Chief Building Official for the Corporation of The Nation Municipality and is responsible for the enforcement of the Ontario Building Code Act, 1992, SO 1992, c 23.and its regulations as amended within the boundaries of The Nation Municipality.
2. That this By-law shall have full effect on the day of its adoption.
3. That By-law #16-2022 is hereby repealed.
