Recommendation

[That the Library Board receive the 2025 Library Operating Forecast for information, noting that the forecast includes only core operational, and staffing costs and excludes discretionary spending.]

Context

This report presents a financial forecast for the 2025 calendar year, based on actual expenditures from January to May and projected expenses from June to December. The objective is to provide a clear picture of the minimum financial commitments necessary to maintain baseline library operations, following the temporary closure and administrative transition.

Report

The total estimated operational expenses for 2025 amount to \$160,262, with projected funding totaling \$200,000, resulting in a forecasted surplus of \$39,738. Key expenditure categories include:
